OVERVIEW & PURPOSE

TEACH Texarkana offers a five day Fall Co-op and a five day Spring Co-op each year to enhance our students' opportunities to learn, play, and make friendship bonds in group settings. A lot of time and effort is put into organizing these co-ops. We could not have these opportunities without the help and cooperation from our TEACH families.

Co-op Rules

1. All students must be registered.
2. All students and parents must read over the TEACH Guidelines for Co-op Classes found under the TEACH Co-op tab on the group website.
3. One parent from each family must attend Co-op with their children. This parent will be assigned an area to help with during Co-op time. This is very important we would not be able to have Co-op without the help of our parents.
4. Students must stay with their teachers for their entire class time.
5. Parents must stay at their designated monitoring or aid position for the entire class time.
6. Cell phones must be put away during Co-op classes.

Tips and General Information

1. Our co-ops are divided by age, not grade level so that students can enjoy time with their peers and get to know some of their classmates.
2. Read over the class descriptions carefully with your students.
3. Do not be afraid to ask questions, we are all just regular moms giving this whole homeschool thing a go!
4. Remember to check email, texts, forum, and Facebook for updates during Co-op season. Sometimes we have to make adjustments due to weather.
5. Don't forget to register your infants for the nursery class!
